### 1. Call to Order

- a. meeting called to order 7:04pm
- b. eBoard meeting members did introductions and listed their "one thing they'd like to see changed"

## 2. Consent Agenda: Single Motion to Approve All Items Listed Below

# 3. Stronger Relationships with BIPOC Communities

- a. Tim kicked off a discussion and was supported by Oletha about the idea of 2-3 Democrats attending other meetings such as LULAC, NAACP, to build strong relationships with other communities.
- b. Oletha mentioned that minority communities have a trust issue with politicians. We also have a tendency to individually attend meetings but not as official representatives of the Democratic party. It's important to start showing up.
- c. Tim mentioned the importance of not showing up before the campaigns and mentioned the importance of Oletha's ideas.
- d. Carolyn Long mentioned the importance of having candidates tag along with representatives that already have a relationship with minority groups.
- e. Terri Niles shared specific examples of joint work that was done in the past with minority groups. This included the NAACP and OneAmerica.
- f. Hector Hinjosa shared links on upcoming events for various organizations and spoke of other possible groups that can be reached.
- g. General discussion about the need for 2-3 folks that should be approached about taking this task on. Donna Sinclair will be approached since she's the outreach contact. More ideas were suggested from the membership.

## 9. Recent Budget Discussions Update

- a. The chair proposed a line item in the budget for outreach. This may include shirts and hats potentially.

- Motion by Terri Niles, 2nd by Patricia O'Bannon. Amend the budget for \$3500 for community outreach purposes. PASSED by majority. no objections, no abstentions.
