- 3.2.6 Dues paying members are those individuals who pay an annual due of an amount to be determined by the CCDCC Executive Committee and approved by the CCDCC body. Dues paying members shall have the same voting privileges as Elected, Appointed, and Acting PCOs (3.2.1 a, b, c) with the exception of voting during reorganization meetings, voting to replace elected democratic officials, amendments to organizational bylaws, and in the replacement of CCDCC Executive Committee elected officers. Additionally, dues paying members are subject to voting eligibility guidelines in Article 8 of these bylaws.
- 8.3 The amount of dues required for dues paying members to be in good standing shall be established by the CCDCC Executive Committee and confirmed by the body at the first meeting following reorganization, or at the earliest meeting that is practical. The Chair, at their discretion, may issue a financial hardship waiver for members at their request.
