Mike will be our liaison to Fuse, Bob to labor, and Emma to the WEA and the State Party, as well.

We currently have plenty of people who will help with the Ogden Dinner, but no lead. It is 40% of our revenue. We need a lead, and/or other fundraising activities, with a lead for those. Other options might include proactive calling of a large list of potential sustaining donors, Kiggins events featuring elected officials and charging admission, or traditional fundraisers at private homes.
5. Office options: Discussion only
Last meeting’s discussion was very helpful. Many members feel passionately about an office, and many feel passionately about reaching out to people where they are more proactively. Our budget is uncertain, especially considering item 4, above. We’d like to find a solution that works for all. Some lower-cost options for having a regular place of our own include Fourth Plain Commons, Luepke Center, or a low-rent office at the Academy or other location.
